You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you.

- Isaiah 26:3

Have you ever left a meeting with someone and felt like a wonderful life-lesson had just dropped into your heart? I experienced this a few weeks ago...

I was sitting with one of our credentialed ministers. In his tiny little room. In the convalescent home he has inhabited for a few years now. Due to Covid, I had not been allowed to visit him for some time and in short summary, little had changed since our last Pre-Covid visit.

As we shared, I asked him to review again with me his journey of ministry. So, he listed the many churches he had pastored, missions trips taken, and seasons—both good and bad—of his work over the years. Most of it sounded quite honestly, painful, challenging, limited. By some accounts it would be determined that he did not have all that of a "successful" ministry. Yet, his conclusion was this: "And you know, Jeff, I wouldn't change a single thing." I responded, "Not a single thing?" To which he replied, "Not a single thing. I have no regrets whatsoever." And, he meant every word.

He is not that old of a man. His health has turned in recent years. His dear wife could no longer take care of him. And, now he sits in a small room day after day...with no regrets whatsoever! It left me conflicted with both conviction and gratitude.

A "no regret" attitude does not come from wonderfully easy and successful memories. It rather springs from a heart of gratitude that acknowledges the incredible mercies of God that are new every morning (Lamentations 3) and follow us all the days of our lives (Psalm 23)—no matter the circumstances!

How to cultivate a "No Regret" kind of attitude:

- Guard your heart from cynicism over the hurts and losses of ministry
- Acknowledge that God is working "all things together" for our own good
- Remember that God weighs and judges people/events differently than we do
- Surrender both the "good" and "bad" events of life fully to Him in worship
- Reflect on His past faithfulness through specific trials and past challenges


