# TIME FOR AN UPGRADE

Years ago, my wife Sue (thankfully) convinced me I needed a new phone because my old one was no longer "cool and contemporary."

After having had the same phone for some time, I must say that "cool and contemporary" are overrated.

You see, I could do many things on that phone: check my Twitter feed, browse the Internet, play chess, text others and even listen to the radio. It had a camera, caller identification, voice recorder, calendar, navigation and a host of other applications.

However, despite all these strengths, that particular phone had one problem. It had never been good at the basics of making phone calls. The thing that all phones are made to do and what I needed most, was deficient in this model. Most phone calls were poor in the sound quality.

I tried getting the phone saved through baptism but that didn't help. It was first sprinkled with Diet Coke and later baptized by immersion in the most common of cell phone rites, the toilet. I need a cell phone and will carry one with me for the rest of my life, but the one thing I needed that piece of technology to do was undeniably deficient.

Unfortunately, I think many believers today are just like that old phone. They do all kinds of "cool" things but they have never become good at the basics of personally embracing and fulfilling Christ's call for their lives.

They are saved and baptized but are not fulfilling the mission that God has for them. They do not live out a Spirit-empowered witness or share about the transforming love of Jesus Christ.


### Sadly, many Christians are in need of an upgrade of spiritual passion and purpose.

We have the message, power and giftings to do all the things needed to impact the world with the message of Christ's love, but often we're stuck in a rut of using methods that no longer are relevant to current cultural needs. An upgrade is required if we're going to reach the lost in this generation.

Jesus made the strong command in Mark 16:15 to "Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature." This mandate was not optional but imperative to the success of the church.

Unlike my old phone, we must be strong and loud in the main thing we are called to accomplish in this life. And the main thing is to fulfill the mission of Christ. Everything else might be "cool and contemporary," but not the sole purpose of the Christian life and of the mission of the Church.

As we enter into 2020, my prayer is that our focus would on the priorities of the Kingdom of God; that we would use every means possible to speak clearly and loudly the message of hope to a hurting world and that we would make a renewed commitment to pray and win the lost like never before.

# MY HEALTH MATTERS!

For several years now the A/G's Influence and Enrichment magazines have placed an emphasis on the mental and emotional health of pastors. Now, our movement has established the AG Mental Health Committee. What a need! Robert Crosby provided an excellent article in last month's Influence magazine, "Soul Care for Servant Leaders." Please click HERE to read it if you have not, and read it again if you have!

Sure, I have an unusual propensity among most pastors; I have absolutely loved pastoral counseling since my early days as a youth pastor at Phoenix First Assembly. Ten years ago, in my opening months at Central Assembly, my admin asked me one day, "Do you always meet with this many people in a given week?" I smiled and answered simply, "Yes." For me, pastoral counseling is a form of discipleship. Crosby references it as a form of sanctification. I have celebrated it as helping people move from where they are to where God wants them to be, and often the struggles are in their minds and emotions and relationships. I have found one-on-one meetings to greatly add to the other ministries our church offers.

I realize this isn't for all pastors. My father loathed counseling in his ministry, something we often laugh together about. Yet, as Crosby states, "Counseling is not some option for the weak, but a strong resource for the wise." He is reaching out to pastors on two counts: for their church members and for themselves. I want to do the same as we enter into 2020 in our great ministry network...

- 1. Please consider your own emotional and mental well-being. If you are struggling, please do not walk alone. Your health will impact the health of your church (and more importantly your marriage and family.)
- 2. Please consider those same needs in the congregation you serve. Studies reveal 1/3 of all Americans are suffering with anxiety. Depression is rampant in our churches. People love Jesus, yet suffer in these areas.
- 3. Please consider giving a sermon series on related topics.
  I am three classes away from completing my course work at GCU for a
  Masters in Professional Counseling. Over these past 2 ½ years of classes,
  my personal reading time has exploded in awareness of such topics in God's
  Word! If you are mindful, God will lead you with biblical answers for your flock.
- 4. Please know our network leadership has prioritized your health by providing for you: elders (for confidential meetings on any topic), myself (for the same), and a list of counselors we refer pastors to on a regular basis (for the same). You are not alone in life and ministry! Every Wednesday morning in our network staff's prayer/devotional time, we pray over a small segment of our pastors and churches. By December, every ordained pastor and every network church has been interceded for. Our prayer is that in 2020 you will be healthy and blessed in every way!




