HOW TO BECOME A CREDENTIALED MINISTER WITH THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD

1

/// MEET THE BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:

Ensure you meet the basic qualifications for credentialing with the AG, which include a personal commitment to Christ, Baptism in the Holy Spirit with evidence of speaking in tongues, agreement with the AG's Statement of Fundamental Truths, and a clear calling to ministry.

/// COMPLETE THE REQUIRED EDUCATION:

The AG typically requires completion of specific educational requirements for credentialing. This may include coursework through an AG-endorsed Bible college or seminary, or through a District School of Ministry like ASOM. Check with the Arizona Ministry Network for specific educational requirements for your desired level of credentialing (Certified, Licensed, or Ordained Minister).

// GAIN MINISTRY EXPERIENCE:

The AG values practical ministry experience. Engage in ministry activities within your local church or another ministry setting to gain experience and demonstrate your calling and gifts in action.

// APPLICATION PROCESS:

Obtain and complete the credentialing application from the Arizona Ministry Network. This process involves providing personal testimony of your salvation and calling to ministry, doctrinal agreement, background checks. references. and

/// COMPLETE REQUIRED EXAMS AND INTERVIEWS:

Depending on the level of credentials you are seeking, you may need to pass a written exam that covers Bible knowledge, AG doctrines, and the AG Constitution and Bylaws. You will also be required to participate in an interview with network officials.

/// RECEIVE APPROVAL AND CREDENTIALING:

After completing all required steps and upon approval by the Arizona Ministry Network's Credential Committee, your credential application will be recommended to the AG National Office in Springfield which formally issues all ministerial credentials. This process culminates in a formal recognition service at our annual Network Conference where new ministers are welcomed and acknowledged.
